


CLARK COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT
STANDARD GUIDELINES ON PERIODS OF PHYSICAL PLACEMENT

The court believes that the following guidelines reflect the statutory placement criteria under Wis. Stat. Sec. 767.24. In individual cases application of the facts to the statutory criteria may warrant a different outcome. **Parents are free to reach an agreement that is different from these guidelines, subject to court approval, as long as the best interests of the children are not harmed.**

Priority of Placements	Holiday, Christmas Eve and Day, parent's days and birthday placements have precedence over general, school year, school holiday vacations, and summer placements.		
Flexibility and Reason	This schedule is a guideline. Parents are free to mutually agree to modify the schedule to fit their needs and the needs of the children. Parents should be flexible to meet each other's needs as well as the needs of the children to participate in extracurricular activities (football, volleyball, band etc.). <i>The court will consider attempts to (1) rigidly enforce this schedule, or (2) repeatedly and unilaterally insist on deviations, without consideration of the other parent's needs and the needs of the children, to be poor parenting and a violation of the spirit of this schedule.</i>

Clark FA 100-Placement Guidelines

*When any one child in school

**Parents may agree to an option of alternating monthly or alternating by school quarters. If they do, there shall be every other weekend placement with the other parent. If no option is selected, the default is alternate 1-week periods.

***Parents can choose either the 1 week or 2 week period. If no option is selected, the default is alternate 2 week periods.

Transportation: If not otherwise agreed, each party shall pick up the child(ren) at the beginning of his or her placement periods.
