Clark FA 100-Placement Guidelines

*When any one child in school

**Parents may agree to an option of alternating monthly or alternating by school quarters. If they do, there shall be every other weekend placement with the other parent. If no option is selected, the default is alternate 1-week periods.

***Parents can choose either the 1 week or 2 week period. If no option is

selected, the default is alternate 2 week periods.

Transportation: If not otherwise agreed, each party shall pick up the child(ren) at the beginning of his or her placement periods.
