## TYPES OF WORTHLESS CHECKS WHICH CANNOT BE PROSECUTED:

- 1. Post-dated checks.
- 2. Checks made payable to "CASH".
- 3. Checks given for past consideration, such as payments on account.
- 4. Third-party checks.
- 5. A check for which partial payment has been accepted prior to submitting it to the District Attorney's office.
- 6. Checks written by an individual that cannot be positively identified.

All of the above are considered civil matters and may be pursued civilly.

\*If a check indicates "Payment Stopped", please indicate the reason payment was stopped, if known.
