TO: All persons interested in winter storage at the Clark County Fairgrounds

RE: Timetable and conditions for storage

Clark County will again offer vehicle storage opportunities at the Fairgrounds for this winter. Storage is on first come – first serve basis. All gates will be locked with no admittance beyond the staging area off of Rock Road prior to 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, November 5, 2022. At 8:00 a.m. in the staging area storage customers will be directed to the appropriate building for the size of their item to be stored. Storage pull-in will continue until approximately 11:00 a.m. (Storage pull-out is scheduled for April 1, 2023 starting at 8:00 a.m. for all items, and will continue up to approximately 11:00 a.m. or until all items are removed.) Please note, overnight parking prior to pull-in is prohibited and any vehicle left unattended will be subject to towing and related fees. Early/Late storage pull-in is available for a fee of \$50 per customer (limit one trip). Additional trips for multiple vehicles will be charged separately. Please contact Daryn Horn, CCFP Facilities Supervisor for individual appointments at 715-743-3845.

Enclosed is a contract for storage — each item stored must have a separate contract. Please make additional copies as needed and bring the completed form(s) and appropriate individual payment(s) for each contract, to turn in on the date of storage pull-in. If a copy is desired for your records, please make it before you arrive since we will not have the capability to make copies on the date of storage pull-in. All stored items must have all batteries, fuel cans, LP tanks, etc. removed prior to storage.

Items being stored will be measured from "nose to tail" including any hitches or extensions protruding beyond the stored item. **Storage fees have changed this year** and are as follows with checks to be made payable to the Clark County Treasurer:

- Items less than 20 feet in length \$150.00 for Nov. 5, 2022 to Apr. 1, 2023.
- Items 20 to 30 feet long \$200.00 for Nov. 5, 2022 to Apr. 1, 2023.
- Items greater than 30 feet in length \$250.00 for Nov. 5, 2022 to Apr. 1, 2023.

All fees and forms will be collected at the pull-in event.



And the said Lessee also covenant and agrees to and with the said Lessor not to assign this Lease without first obtaining the written consent of the said Lessor, and that Lessee will, at the expiration of the time herein recited, quietly yield and surrender the aforesaid premises to the said Lessor heirs and assigns, in as good condition and repair as when Lessee took them, reasonable wear and tear and damage by the elements alone accepted.

And the said Lessee agrees that the purpose of this indenture is to facilitate long-term storage. That stored vehicles may not be available for intermittent pull-in and pull-out. The extra costs incurred for early or late pull-in or pull-out, or showing of any vehicle for sale, will be at Lessee's expense. All stored items must have all batteries, fuel cans, LP tanks, etc. removed prior to storage.
