The following winter ATV/snowmobile trails are OPEN; Thorp, Dorchester, Colby, Riplinger and Loyal. Saturday January 21, 2023 all remaining Clark County winter ATV/snowmobile trails including the county forest will be open Saturday January 21, 2023 at 6AM. Trail Y from STH 10 to Lindsey for the Loyal club remains closed.

TRAILS REMAINING CLOSED

Loyal Sno Angels: (Trail Y from STH 10 to Lindsey remains CLOSED)

Expect early season riding conditions. Use extreme caution when riding. There are some areas with open water and open water can be present anywhere. There are also areas with icy patches, thin base, rough and/or some soft agricultural fields. Grooming operations will be taking place. Riders must yield to all groomers. Remember that riding on closed trails is trespassing. Please stay on the trail and respect the private landowners that allow snowmobiling on their property.

LOGGING ACTIVITY

Please use caution while riding trails in the Clark County Forest. There are several areas where logging operations are taking place. Trucks will be hauling on forest roads and snowmobile trails. Some snowmobile trails are plowed. Please slow down, yield to logging equipment and use caution.

Please reference the Clark County winter ATV/snowmobile map for further clarification on exact club locations. Please follow the color coded trails for each club as well as intersection numbers. You can also learn where ATVs are allowed.
